



Understanding Endoscopy Billing for our Ambulatory Surgery Centers

There will be three or more separate claims billed to your insurance company for your procedure at our ASC so you could potentially get three or more bills that will be your responsibility.

- 1) Physician claim – We will submit a claim to your insurance for the physician who is performing your Endoscopy. If you have any patient responsibility you will get a bill from that physician.
- 2) Facility Claim – We will submit a claim to your insurance for the ASC your procedure is performed at. If you have any patient responsibility you will get a bill from that ASC.
- 3) Anesthesia – The anesthesia claim will be submitted by the anesthesia provider the performs the MAC sedations (Also known as monitored anesthesia care). If you have any patient responsibility you will get a bill from the anesthesia provider.
- 4) Pathology – If you have a biopsy or specimen taken during your procedure, we will send to that to the laboratory. They will submit a claim to your insurance. If you have any patient responsibility you will get a bill from that laboratory.
